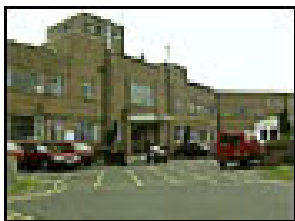

1941: Japanese planes bomb Pearl Harbour

Japan launches a surprise attack on American bases in the Pacific and declares it is at war with Britain and the United States.



1983: Transplant makes British medical history

Surgeons have successfully completed the first heart and lung transplant operation to be performed in Britain.



1990: Tunnel links UK and Europe

Britain and France are joined for the first time in thousands of years as the last wall of rock separating two halves of the Channel Tunnel is removed.
