What we do in year 7:

Hori7on is a 4 cycle programme made up of the subjects: History, Geography, Enterprise and Creative Expression. The aim is for students to work across subjects holistically whilst working for more substantial outcomes at Key Stage 3 with extended periods of time being allocated to subjects. Each subject area creates unique experiences for students and each cycle is ended with a Show Case of work which is open to parents to view. We also use the extended time to specifically focus on the cross-curricular development of literacy and numeracy.

What we do in year 8:

Approximate Dates	Big Question/ Theme	Key Learning Outcomes
Autumn Term 1	Portraiture	Students will learn how to create portraits looking at scale, proportion and accuracy.
Autumn Term 2	Alternative Portraits	Students look at portrait artists and their working methods. Students will experiment different ways of producing portraits.
Spring Term 1	Pop Art	Students will undertake an investigation into Pop Art and its features.
Spring Term 2	Pop Art	Students will build of knowledge of scale and explore a range of materials
Summer Term 1	Cultural appreciation	Students will investigate artworks from different cultures.
Summer Term 2	Cultural appreciation	Students will produce 3 dimensional work building on understanding of different cultures.
