Spring Term 1	The use of scientific research methods in psychology	To understand and use types of data, descriptive statistics, computation and quantitative data display.
Spring Term 2	Understanding the functions and processes of our memories	To understand key concepts in human memory including processes of memory, structures of memory and models of memory.
Summer Term 1	Understanding the functions and processes of our memories	To plan and conduct a focused piece of research based on relevant literature on the topic of human memory.
Summer Term 2	Understanding the functions and processes of our memories	To apply psychological knowledge and understanding of the specified Paper 1 content in a range of contexts.
