Dear Parents/Carers

There is some misunderstanding around access to toilets which I know has caused concern.

It has never been policy to allow students to freely go to the toilet during lessons. For those that do need to visit the toilet more frequently we issue a toilet pass. We recognise that adolescence can be a difficult time for girls and we will, of course, always accommodate their needs.

The change is that students are asked to collect a key from a nearby office to unlock the door.

By monitoring access, I am stopping students using toilets as a social space which sometimes leads to damage and other younger students may find this uncomfortable.

At break, lunch times, before and at the end of the day, toilets are available as normal.

We will continually review the situation and adapt as and when we need. I hope that clarifies the situation and I thank you for your on-going support.
