Dear Parents/Carers

As we end the term I would like to thank our students and staff for their fantastic commitment, teamwork and energy. The latest FoQus newsletter showcases their work and I hope you enjoy sharing the many successes achieved.

I am sure you will join us in thanking the staff who are leaving at the end of this term and we wish them success in their new roles.

Our partnership with parents and carers is continuing to grow in strength and we were delighted with the support for the recent Parents' Forum. Again, this provided an opportunity to share new curriculum and examination developments while also answering general queries about Academy life.

Issues have continued with some students not returning home at the expected time. On almost every occasion we find that the child has gone to a friend's house without informing parents.
