What we do in year 9:

Approximate Dates	Big Question/ Theme	Key Learning Outcomes
Autumn Term 1	Introduction to textiles techniques and processes	Students are introduced to a range of techniques and materials
Autumn Term 2	Floral fashion project	Students undertake a series of skills workshops and learn how to use the sewing machines.
Spring Term 1	Floral fashion project	Students produce a series of final pieces relevant to their intentions.
Spring Term 2	Floral fashion project	Students build confidence in using new techniques and look at fashion designers to influence their ideas.
Summer Term 1	Bag construction	Students design and construct a bag which includes decorative techniques looked at in their floral fashion project.
Summer Term 2	Printmaking	Students undertake a series of printmaking workshops. These include mono-printing, press-printing and screen-printing.

What we do in year 10:

Approximate Dates	Big Question/ Theme	Key Learning Outcomes
Autumn Term 1	Sweets, biscuits and cakes project: Contextual studies	Students commence a body of work looking at a range of artists and designers.
Autumn Term 2	Sweets, biscuits and cakes project: Experimentation	Students explore a series of techniques developing patterns and prints.
Spring Term 1	Sweets, biscuits and cakes project: Refining Ideas	Students design a series of constructed pieces in response to the theme.
Spring Term 2	Sweets, biscuits and cakes project: Final pieces	Students construct a dress/shirt in response to the theme. Student analyse and evaluate their ideas throughout this process.
Summer Term 1	Pattern project	Students undertake an self directed project linking to the theme of pattern. Students look at mixed media pieces and look at combining techniques.
Summer Term 2	Pattern project	Students undertake an self directed project linking to the theme of pattern. Students look at mixed media pieces and look at combining techniques.
