Globalisation - what it is and how it works, how and why exploitation occurs. Need case study specific examples for both.
Music		Learn the notes of Em pentatonic scale. Practise improvisations on the keyboard (use online virtual keyboards or phone apps if you do not have a keyboard). Listen to examples of good improvisations. Why are they effective?
Drama		Students should be familiar with the stock characters, the exaggerated style of the genre and slapstick comedy as a dramatic device.

RE	Animal rights vs Human rights	Students will be assessed on the various ethical and religious issues surrounding the use of animals by humans. Students must revise the religious quotes and teachings they have been taught in their lessons as well as the different ways animals are used by humans. They should use their exercise books to do this and can also use BBC bitesize.
History	Second World War	Students can use online revision resources such as the BBC Bitesize website to improve knowledge of the Second World War. Other online resources include the John D Clare website and the activehistory website. You can guide students through the content on these and perhaps so short 'knowledge tests' afterwards.

Art	Students are learning portraits, Pop Art and cultures.	Students to use their knowledge of line, colour and texture to create an imaginative piece using a range of materials.
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
