As we prepare for the Whitsun break I would like to thank you for your support during an extremely busy half-term, and in particular, parents of Year 11 and 6th Form for your encouragement during the examination season.

In our continued drive to raise standards I would also like to remind you about the arrangements for the start of the Academy day.

All students are expected to be in the Academy by 8.55am at the latest. This gives them an opportunity to go to lockers in time for a prompt start to lessons at 9.00am. Any students arriving after 8.55am will be deemed late and will therefore serve a detention. Please also encourage your child to enjoy the complimentary toast and juice provided each morning from 8.15am to 8.45am.
