Students will be able to collect their examination results from 10.00 am on Thursday 20th August 2015.

Study Leave will be granted to students from 29th June 2015 onwards. I trust that we can rely on your support to ensure excellent attendance until the end of the examinations period. If you require any further clarification please contact your child's Personalising Learning Director.

On Friday 26th June we will be holding the Leavers' Service at St Margaret's Church, commencing at 2.30 pm prompt with an anticipated finish at 3.30 pm (students will be expected to make their own way home from the church). Prior to the start of the service the students are invited to a buffet lunch (details to be confirmed).

The annual Prom will take place on Friday 3rd July and all students who have met the Academy's expectations relating to behaviour, attendance (minimum of 96%) and examination/coursework preparation will shortly be receiving their personal invitations. Students will also have a second interview in August to confirm their subject choices following the release of the GCSE results.
